Pultyniewicz coordinates the County's efforts to educate residents of single-family homes and multi-family apartments and condominiums, and employees and businesses about the County's recycling regulations, as well as information about reducing waste, reusing materials, recycling, buying recycled products, backyard composting and grasscycling. Prior to becoming Recycling Coordinator in 2006, Mr. Pultyniewicz served as the program manager of both the County's Business Recycling Program and the Multi-Family Recycling Program. He joined the Division as a program specialist with the Business Recycling Program in 2000.
