- Further their vocational development through acquaintance with others of the same profession
- Make new friends around the world
- Explore new opportunities for service
- Have fun and enhance their Rotary experience

Rotary Fellowships began informally in 1928 when Rotarians with a shared interest in the international language Esperanto joined together. In 1947, a group of Rotarian boating enthusiasts began flying the Rotary flag from their crafts, calling themselves the International Yachting Fellowship of Rotarians — which now holds the distinction of being the oldest continuing fellowship. The scope of fellowships has changed significantly over the years, but their purpose remains the same: to unite Rotarians in friendship and provide opportunities to enjoy favorite recreational or professional activities.

June 15: Watershed Development and Drinking Water for Tribal People in Bhorghar area , Maharashtra State (India)- Interim Progress Report



Dr. Anilkumar Latey has been member of the Rotary Club of Poona Downtown for last 36 years and he also served as President of RCPD in 1997- 1998. Dr. Latey received his MS and PhD degrees in Zoology from the University of Pune and Bombay, respectively. He served on the faculty as a lecturer and professor of zoology for 40 years at the University of Pune and retired in 2000. He taught several zoology courses to graduate and post-graduate level students and conducted research. He published five books and authored several research articles in zoological sciences and served as a mentor to MS and PhD candidates. He was a visiting professor at the School of Life sciences , University of West Indies, Port of Spain in Trinidad under a Rotary Scholar Grant in 1999. Over the years as a rotary member, he has been involved in spear heading several projects and made several presentations to numerous clubs in India and many countries around the world. His wife (Meena) is also a devoted member of the Rotary Club of Poona Downtown.
