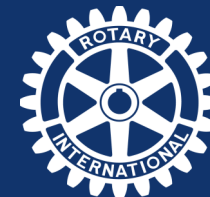

Tree Talk

Colter Burkes, the county arborist for Montgomery Parks, gave an interesting talk at last week's meeting.

Tree Nursery—The county raises its own trees at the Pope Farm in the upper county and plants more than 1200 trees each year.

Removing Diseased Trees—The county has cut down more than 4000 ash trees, primarily in Rock Creek Park, following the devastating invasion of the emerald ash borer. The insect arrived in Montgomery County in 2012 and has killed thousands of trees in the county.

Tree Inventory—Colter's group has collected information on more than 20,000 trees, mostly in community parks. The county generally follows the US Forest Service model for counting trees. Park users can learn about trees through a mobile app called "Open Tree Map," which has details on trees in 76 of the Montgomery County parks.

Tree Preservation—The county checks on trees, especially those near private property, for hazards and treatment.

Tree Planting—We're hoping to work with Colter to revive our Rotary Tree Planting project. He agreed to help!
